Dear Registered Voter:

With the passage of Proposal 3 in November 2018, Michigan voters no longer need to provide a reason on their application for an absentee ballot. If you would like to be a voter that will receive an absentee ballot **application** for each election, you may add your name to our list of Permanent Absentee voters. If you choose to join this list, you will receive an absentee ballot **application** in the mail approximately 45 days prior to each election. **The application will need to be completed and returned to my office in order to receive an absentee ballot.**

You may join the Permanent Absentee list by simply contacting my office through emailing elections@hudsonville.org or returning the bottom portion below to Hudsonville City Hall, 3275 Central Boulevard, Hudsonville, MI 49426.

Voters on the Permanent Absentee List do not *have* to vote by mail. If you would prefer to vote in person for any particular election, do not complete the absentee ballot application you receive in the mail. Instead, simply vote in person at your precinct between the hours of 7am and 8pm on Election Day. Note: Voting in person will <u>not</u> remove your name from the Permanent Absentee List. If you would rather always vote in person, you may remove your name from the list at any time list by contacting my office.
