

HUDSONVILLE CITY COMMISSION
City Commission Minutes

July 14, 2020

Mayor Northrup called a Work Session of the Hudsonville City Commission to order on Tuesday, July 14, 2020 at 6:30 PM.

Present: Mayor Northrup, Commissioners Brandsen, Bolhuis, DeVree, Leerar, Raterink, Steigenga, City Manager Waterman, Department of Works Superintendent Miller, Senior Mechanic Ondersma, Planning/Zoning Director Strikwerda and City Clerk VanSlyke.

9410. Discussion on Name for New Park.

The City Commission discussed the naming of the new park that is located on the site of the former Summergreen Golf Course. Planning/Zoning Director Strikwerda gave a history of the land and stated that the property and additional funds were donated to the city for the purpose of creating a park and bike path. Strikwerda reviewed the results of an online survey that had been completed and the Planning Commission's recommendation. The City Commission discussed the recommended park name and felt that they would prefer to table this discussion for a few months so they could review name possibilities.
