Motion by Raterink, seconded by Brandsen, to approve accepting and authorizing execution of a license agreement and a first amendment to easement agreements between the City of Hudsonville and Andrew Wesley Peterson and Donna Ruth Peterson of 3031 Clearview Drive to allow for the use of city-owned property for a private golf course.

Planning & Zoning Director Strikwerda reviewed and answered questions on this agreement and the current zoning use.
